Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Travel. A deposit of \$250 per person is required to secure reservations. All major credit cards are also accepted. **Final payment is due on or before December 5, 2009.**

Cancellations, Refunds and Insurance: Cancellations must be made in writing and are subject to a \$50 service fee. In addition to the service fee, cancellation penalties are as follows:
Prior to December 15, 2009 - Full refund.
December 16 - January 24, 2010 - \$250.
January 25 - February 14, 2010 - 50% of gross fare.
After February 15, 2009 - no refund.
